The EAC has reviewed Engineering Change Order (ECO) 1151, including supporting documentation and analysis provided by the voting system test lab. The ECO impacts the EVS 6.0.6.0, EVS 6.2.0.0, and EVS 6.3.0.0 systems. This minor change to the DS950 firmware to enhance performance of the output tray, does not alter the system's reliability, functionality, capability, or operation. Based on the information provided, it has been determined that the testing conducted is sufficient.
