

## Vote by Mail Voting November 6, 2012 Presidential Election

"More registered voters than 42 of the 50 states."

Ballots Cast "More than 70% of the electorate cast ballots."

Vote by Mail ballots mailed to voters in the election. This represents 1,826,492 the largest number of Vote by Mail ballots mailed by any County in California. Nearly four of every ten registered voters in Los Angeles County 39% requested a Vote by Mail ballot. Ballots issued to Permanent Vote by Mail (PVBM) voters. PVBM 1,224,786 voters accounted for 67% of Vote by Mail ballots issued. Number of Vote by Mail Ballots returned in the election. More than 975,828 half (53%) of voters returned a Vote by Mail ballot (by mail or at the polls). 30% Percentage of total ballots cast that were Vote by Mail ballots. Vote by Mail ballots that were returned "in-person" at a polling place, 227,121 on Election Day, or at the Elections Office.

**30,190** Ballots mailed to Military and Overseas voters.
