What is the Key Election System Issue

- Military Voter Registration Not the Problem
 - 71% = General Electorate
 - 77% = Military voters
- Voter Participation Rates not the problem
 - 62% = General Electorate
 - 53% = Military voters
 - 71% = Adjusted military voters
- Overwhelming voting failure is in ballot delivery and return times
- Absentee Ballot Return Rates:
 - 91% = General Population
 - 67% = UOCAVA voters
 - 62% = Military Voters

Check Status of Your Ballot

Under the federal Help America Vote Act (HAVA) of 2002, every voter who casts a provisional ballot is entitled to find out from his/her **county elections official** if the ballot was counted and if not, the reason why it was not counted.

Under California <u>Elections Code section 3017</u>, a voter who casts a vote-by-mail ballot can find out if the ballot arrived at his/her <u>county elections office</u>. Some county elections officials also tell voters if the vote-by-mail ballot was counted and if it wasn't, the reasons why it was not counted.


Each county elections official allows voters to check the status of his/her vote-by-mail and provisional ballot either through the county website, by telephone, or both.

To find out if your vote-by-mail ballot was received by your county elections official or if your provisional ballot was counted, please click on the appropriate link below or call the phone number listed for the county elections office. Drive voters to FVAP.gov







FVAP would score itself as successful for States:
