Betty Weimer, General Registrar – Prince William County, Virginia

Ms. Weimer was appointed Chief Deputy Registrar in 1985 and General Registrar in 2003. She has professional certifications for Virginia from the Weldon Cooper Center at the University of Virginia and the Elections Center, Houston, Texas. She is an active member of the Voter Registrar Association of Virginia and served as a Regional Director for two years. Ms. Weimer participated in the development of the updated state system Virginia uses as their data base for registrations and elections. She has been a part of conducting 90 elections including seven presidential general elections. Ms. Weimer was the primary administrator for Prince William County successfully pursuing being exempt from Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965. She has also administered three Census redistricting and the conversion from mechanical voting equipment to Direct Recording Equipment. Since 1985 Prince William County has grown from 60, 200 voters to 231,500.
