

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

Provisional Ballots as a % of all Statewide Ballots


(Top-Six States)

■ 2012 **■** 2008



Why were provisional ballots rejected?

- Unregistered (45%)
- Registered, at wrong precinct (11%)
- Registered, at wrong jurisdiction (7%)
- No identification (4%)
- Incomplete/Illegible ballot (4%0)
- Other (32%)

Who has a problem at the polling place?

- In 2012, 2 percent reported experiencing a problem at the polls.
- 19 percent of these reported casting a provisional ballot.
- Those under 30 years of age (4.6% reported experiencing a problem), African-Americans (3.1%), and Latinos (3.0%) were above the mean.
