 - Boston: Spanish, Chinese and Vietnamese
 - Chelsea, Holyoke, Lawrence, Lynn, Revere, Southbridge, Springfield, and Worcester: Spanish
 - Lowell: Spanish and Khmer
 - Malden and Quincy: Chinese

Voter Registration Materials

- The Secretary of the Commonwealth provides all voter registration forms.
 - Available in English, Spanish, Chinese, Vietnamese, Khmer, Portuguese, Haitian Creole, Russian and Cape Verdean.
- Online Voter Registration System is available in English, Spanish, Chinese and Khmer.

Ballots and Supplies

- State law provides that the Secretary of the Commonwealth print and distribute ballots for state primaries and state elections.
- This includes supplies, such as absentee ballot applications and absentee ballot envelopes.

Information for Voters Booklet

Information regarding statewide ballot questions.

Includes:

- Question
- Summary
- Statements to the effect of a yes and no vote
- Arguments for and against
- □ Fiscal impact statements
- □ Full text of the proposed law

Information for Voters Booklet

- Distributed to each household.
- □ Available at each polling place.
- We work with community organizations to distribute to areas with language needs.
- Printed in English, Spanish, Chinese, Large Print and Khmer.
- Audio and Braille versions available as well.

Translation Process

- □ Use professional translation company.
- Drafts provided back to municipality for review.
 - Checking for local nuances in dialect and terminology.
