I move that the Commission hereby authorizes the Executive Director to amend the state instructions portion of the Federal Mail Voter Registration Form when the Chief State Election Official of a state notifies the U.S. Election Assistance Commission of a permanent change in the state's mailing address for receiving voter registration application forms. The Executive Director may make such amendment only after providing written notice to each commissioner and receiving no objection after a 48-hour period.

Pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act (APA), the U.S. Election Assistance Commission finds that notice and public procedure on this change are unnecessary or contrary to the public interest.

All other requests from Chief State Election Officials for changes to the Federal Mail Voter Registration Form shall be considered after the Commission has established its rules and procedures in accordance with the APA.
